Princeton Landing Continuation School

The philosophy of Princeton Landing High School is to support all students in their pursuit of an education. Princeton Landing High School is its own school separate from Princeton Jr/Sr High School although the classes could be held on the same campus. The goal of our staff would be to provide a solid education for students who are credit deficient and or are in need of an alternative educational setting. It is also the goal of this school to get kids back to PHS. Students who wish to return to Princeton High School would be able to do so if they met the requirements of a contract signed when entering the continuation school. The contract most certainly would include credit recovery requirements, but could also include attendance and behavior expectations. It is also important to note that our continuation school should not detract from our current high school in any way. It should enhance our school and provide clearer expectations for students wishing to graduation from PHS.

Minutes per day: 188

School calendar: 180 days of instruction. The calendar will follow the same dates as our current district calendar.

Enrollment: TBD (Possibly 2 – 7 Students)

Grades: **10**th – **12**th

<u>Enrollment Criteria:</u> Students who are more than a semester behind on credits and facing the possibility of not graduating will be eligible for enrollment.

<u>Graduation Requirements:</u> 200 credits (this is 35 less than PHS)

<u>Extracurricular Activities:</u> Because the continuation school has less stringent minute and graduation requirements, its students are not eligible for extracurricular (FFA, Clubs, Sports).

<u>Curriculum:</u> Curriculum for the continuation school will be independent in nature. Students will be able to make up credits on a pace that is suitable to their graduation needs. The independent curriculum allows for students to acquire more than the 35 credits per semester that a PHS student is limited to.
